

These layers could be evaluated in the context of space, culture, history, sociability or topography. The studio consolidates how architecture is involved to society and "place". The project scope is an identified urban pattern that will be chosen by the student in the given part of the city. Project comprise 5.000-8.000 m² closed area, with the educational function. 3 parts of the city will be in the focus of this project:

### Midterm Jury Submission - 1st Jury

- All presentation boards should be designed in A4 or its related dimensions (A3, A2, A1, A0)

- You should upload your works both to UES and OneDrive folder.

#### Content:

- Contextual and urban analysis
- Works explaining the relationship between analysis and the idea/ Explaining the phase from analyses to concept idea.
- Explaining the PROGRAM of your functions (research about your functions, sizes, capacities etc.)

1/2000, 1/1000 scaled set:

- Analysis (urban, socio-cultural, morphological...)
- Site plan decisions and proposals with immediate surroundings
- Silhouettes, sections (with the surrounding)
- 1/1000 Physical Model (with the surrounding and proposals)

1/500 scaled set:

- All sections should contain the whole project area including levels, fittings and all things seen.
